John Nys - AKC US World Agility Team Member/Coach

John has been competing on the local, national and international dog agility stage for over 25 years. John has competed successfully with multiple canine partners in the small, medium and large dog divisions. During this time frame, he has earned over 30 Master Agility Champion titles. He is a 10-time International World Team Member with 4 different canine partners. John has represented the US 8 times as an AKC World Team member at the FCI Agility World Championships, and 3 times at the European Open Championships. He has most recently been Assistant Coach on the FCI AWC team and has been selected to be the 2025 AKC US World Agility Team Coach. He has earned 5 Silver Medals and 1 Gold Medal in AWC competition, which includes being an Individual Overall Combined Silver Medalist.

John has been an avid AKC supporter as evident in many years of competing at AKC Nationals reflected in placements in the top 3 on over 11 occasions.

John's accomplishments have been earned and realized through the dedication and training of all his canine partners, for which none of this would have been possible without them.
